

**COLONEL CHARLES A. GREEN**  
**Commandant, U.S. Army Military Police School**

Colonel Charlie Green is a Distinguished Military Graduate from Newberry College in South Carolina with a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations. Colonel Green is a graduate of the Military Police Officer Basic and Captain's Career Course, the Command and General Staff College, and the National War College. He holds three master's degrees, one in Business and Organizational Security Management from Webster University, Policy Management from Georgetown University, and National Security and Strategic Studies from the National War College.



Colonel Green has served in a variety of command, staff, and leadership positions from platoon leader to brigade commander. His first assignment was as the Executive Officer in Echo Company, 795th Military Police Battalion and later Platoon Leader in 463d Military Police Company at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Colonel Green deployed his platoon to Doha, Qatar. As a Captain, he deployed with the 18th Military Police Brigade in OIF 04-06, and later commanded 92d Military Police Company in Baumholder, Germany. Following command, Colonel Green was selected for the Joint Chiefs of Staff / Army Staff Intern Program where he served as the Executive Assistant to the Director-J-5 Middle East, a planner with the Army G-3 ODO and the Office of the Provost Marshal General, and as the Executive Officer to the Assistant Command General for Police Development in the Combined Security Transition Command Afghanistan. As a Major, Colonel Green served as the Operations Officer and Executive Officer in the 95th Military Police Battalion in Sembach, Germany, followed by serving as the Military Police Field Grade Assignment Officer at U.S. Army Human Resource Command. Next, Colonel Green served as the Deputy Brigade Commander for the 89th Military Police Brigade and then commanded the 720th Military Police Battalion and while simultaneously serving as the Provost Marshal at Fort Cavazos, Texas.

Following Battalion Command, Colonel Green served as the Director of the Commander's Action Group for the III Corps and Fort Cavazos Commanding General. He then deployed to Afghanistan to serve as the Chief of Staff for the Ministry Advisory Group-Interior and Senior Advisor to the Deputy Minister for Security. Next Colonel Green was assigned to United States Army Pacific Headquarters as the Director for Concepts and then commanded the 8th Military Police Brigade and simultaneously served as the Director of Emergency Services for U.S. Army Garrison Hawaii. Currently, COL Green serves as the 53d Commandant and Chief of the Regiment for the Military Police Corps at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

Colonel Green's awards and decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal (1OLC), the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC), the Army Commendation Medal (3OLC), the Army Parachutist Badge, and the Joint Staff and Army Staff Identification Badges.
